History

Qatar Olympic Committee (QOC) established the Qatar Anti-doping Commission (QADC) on 7 March 2005, to carry out the Anti-Doping Functions on behalf of QOC, with the objective of acting as the independent Anti-Doping Organisation for Qatar.

To comply with the International Anti-Doping Rules, State of Qatar was accepted the World Anti-Doping Code on 7th February 2007, and ratified the ratified the UNESCO International Convention against Doping in Sport on 24 August 2007.

As a non-profit, national governmental organisation, our programs:

- Planning, coordinating, implementing, monitoring and advocating improvements in Doping Control;
- Cooperating with other relevant national organisations and other Anti-Doping Organisations;
- Encouraging reciprocal Testing between National Anti-Doping Organisations;
- Provide specialist advise for Qatar National Sport Federations in doping issue;
- Implement a single anti-doping regulation to govern all Qatar National Sport Federations;
- Promoting anti-doping research;
- Planning, implementing and monitoring information and education programmes.
